PURPOSE:

- * Educators in the Fresno area gain exposure to examples of innovative school models and practices
- * Educators join together to practice designing a coherent school model built to prepare students for the realities of tomorrow



URGENCY:

- * Only 33.2% of students are proficient in ELA and 23.8% are proficient in Math, with stark achievement gaps for students of color, English Learners and Special Education
- * Despite increased graduation and A-G rates, most graduates (65.3%) are not prepared for college level coursework
- * "Tired, bored and stressed" - These are the top three adjectives high school students use to describe their school experience, according to a national survey
- * Advanced automation is rapidly disrupting employment, students will need deeper cognitive, social and emotional intelligence skills to compete in living wage job markets

Beginning the week of February 5th there will be a commitment of...

- * 4-6 learning sessions with accompanying pre-readings
(days to be determined based on applications)
- * At least one local site visit during a school day
(would require subs for current teachers)
- * At least one out-of-town visit during a school day or conversations with out-of-town educators
- * One full day for design session
